## **Suggested Materials List**

A set of **pastel pencils and/or Nupastels.** The more colors, the better.

Utility knife (to sharpen pastel pencils and Nupastels)

Tracing paper, 6-8 pieces, sizes about 8.5" x 11" to 11" x 14"

Graphite or mechanical pencil

Eraser

Artist's tape

Stompe/stump/tortillon (opt.)

4-6 sheets of an old **newspaper** (will be used for padding)

A **ballpoint pen** (must be ballpoint, not fine point) or a **stylus** 

**6-8 sheets** of white drawing paper (no Bristol board or very smooth paper such as copy paper), pastel paper (textured or not), or watercolor paper (not hot pressed). You may also bring any of the above in different colors to experiment with. Recommended paper size range: 8.5" x  $11" - 11" \times 14"$ . Larger paper can be cut down at the SSAC. Do not bring mounted paper, boards, or thick paper.

A **drawing board** that can accommodate the size of your sheets of paper (SSAC has some boards for student use)

**Reference materials**: simple still life objects (veggies, fruits, etc.) or photographs of simple items, landscapes, pets, designs, etc.

**Comfort items:** an apron or work clothes, lunch/snacks/beverage (SSAC has refrigerator you can use)
